Go West on Kingston Edmonds Ferry to WA SR 104 8.5 miles

Go Northwest on WA SR 104 to WA SR 3 9.0 miles

Go South on WA SR 3 toward Bremerton 16.5 miles

Take the Newberry Hill exit and follow the signs to Seabeck

Port Angeles to Seabeck

Go Southeast on US 101 to WA SR 104 37.0 miles

Go Southeast on WA SR 104 (portions toll) to WA SR 3 15.5 miles

Go South on WA SR 3 toward Bremerton 16.5 miles

Take the Newberry Hill exit and follow the signs to Seabeck

Tacoma to Seabeck

Go South on I-5 to WA SR 16 (Exit 132) .9 miles

Go Northwest on WA SR 16 (pass Bremerton)
to WA SR 3 27.0 miles

Go North on WA SR 3 9.7 miles

Take the Newberry Hill exit and follow the signs to Seabeck
